



The third annual Miss Rodeo Canada Alumni Pageant Seminar will take place in Olds, Alberta from May 13-15. The purpose of this seminar is to provide rodeo royalty, and those hoping to run for a title, in Canada the opportunity to be given first hand knowledge and advice from Miss Rodeo Canada Alumni and other special guest. This seminar will cover all pageant events, which includes horsemanship, public speaking, personal interview, written exam, modeling, appearance and personality. It will be open to girls 15 years of age and above interested in pursuing local or national rodeo queen titles as well as queen committee members.

As a participant, you will be given the opportunity to partake in one-on-one and group work with guidance from the alumni and special guest speakers. You will be given a study package on your arrival, breakfast is included in the room rate and lunch and dinner will be provided (please inform us if you have any particular food allergies that we need to be aware of). As an observer, you will be allowed to watch and listen to each seminar portion only. If you wish to purchase a study package for \$20, please indicate on the registration form. Your registration fees also include meals for each day.

The seminar will take place at the Ramada Inn & Suites in Olds and the Olds College Arena. If you are in need of accommodations please let us know by circling one of the three options on the registration form. The hotel has set aside rooms for the seminar weekend at a reduced rate for \$119/night. We would like to know if you are willing to share a room with another seminar participant or if you would like to reserve one for yourself. You are also welcome to make bookings on your own.

We ask that each participant wear western attire throughout the seminar, this includes; a button up western shirt (however, no sparkly arena shirts please), jeans, boots and cowboy hat. You will not have to wear your hat for the entirety of the seminar but we ask that you have it on hand at all times.

All attendees must pay in full by May 1, 2015. Cancellation period will be open until May 11, 2014 with full refund of registration fee. After May 11th, you will only be refunded half of your registration fee. After the cancellation period each participant will be sent a schedule for the seminar along with a short 1-2 minute speech that you must have memorized for the public speaking portion of the seminar.
